BASIC COMPREHENSION QUESTIONS:

- What type or species of butterflies are Violett's parents, Mr. and Mrs. Vamos?

- Which animals made fun of Violett because of her pink color?
- How did Violett react at first after the dragonflies teased her?
- Who encouraged Violett to be proud of her pink color?
- When Violett was flying in the air, she saw a long line of animals, insects, and birds standing in line near a building. Why were these animals standing in line?
- What was unusual about the appearance of the animals standing in line?
- How did the producers of the dance show react to Violett's dance audition?
- Violett told the zebra that he had been a good friend to her. What evidence do you see in the story that indicates that the zebra was a good friend to Violett?
